

## 2019 First-Year Student Satisfaction Survey

#### Observations

Moderately strong response rate with a comparable distribution demographically by race/ethnicity. Male respondents were significantly lower than female, but rebounded somewhat from last year - 32% versus 24% in 2018.

The majority of the responses for the 34 aspects of University life were positive. Only four items had a mean score lower than 3.0 (Satisfied). Similar to the past four years, the Ames Library had the largest average score (3.57) based on a four-point scale, while SODEXO Dining Services had the lowest average score (2.44) (4 = Very Satisfied to 1 = Very Dissatisfied).

**Six** items had a combined dissatisfaction rating of 20% or greater (i.e., Very Dissatisfied & Dissatisfied) - two less from last year.

**Repeat Offenders:** Health Services, First-Year Residence Hall, Gateway Course, and SODEXO. **New to the list:** Class Registration and Financial Aid Package.

**Eighty-three percent** of the student respondents indicated that they would still choose to enroll at IWU, if they could select their college again - one percentage point higher than last year.

**Fifty percent** of the student respondents indicated that they considered transferring. This is the highest level recorded on this survey.

"Affordability" continued to be identified as the most frequent reason for transfer consideration, with an increase of eight percentage points from the previous year - 29% versus 21%.

"Intercollegiate Athletics" (.651) had the highest overall correlation with overall satisfaction, emphasizing the great importance of sports to those students participating. "Social Experience" (.538) continued to have a significant relationship with satisfaction - this is a consistent finding over the years. Academic items were also significantly prevalent towards overall satisfaction: "Quality of Teaching" and "Academic Experience" (.533 and .535, respectively).

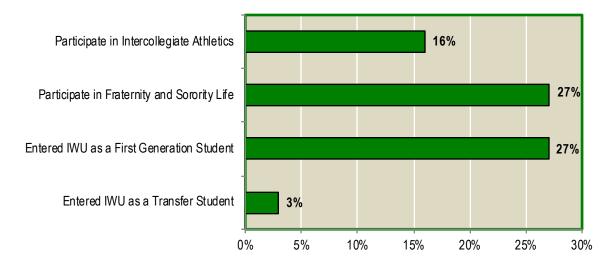

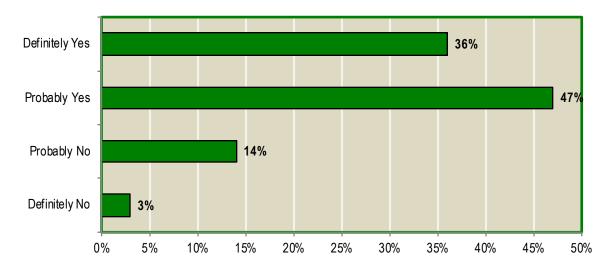

#### If you could select your college again, Would you still choose to enroll at IWU?



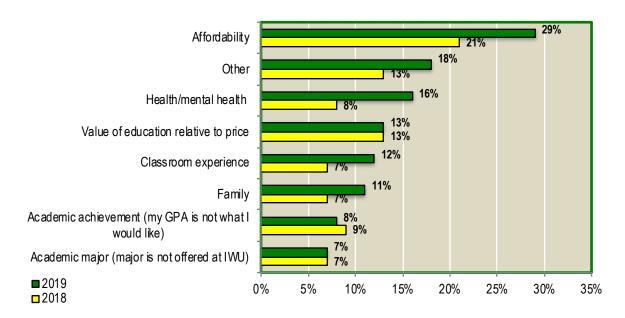
