Scope & Content Note:

This collection contains books by and about John Wesley Powell and the American West from the time of Spanish exploration to the present. As represented here, "The West" includes parts of the United States considered western in the time period Powell's explorations took place and contains subjects related to what is now known as the Midwest. Reports of Powell's explorations and from agencies he went on to direct a large component of these volumes.

This collection also contains books related to the 19th Century Pueblo Pottery Collection held at Illinois Wesleyan University. The pottery collection is named in Powell's honor and is available to virtual visitors at
