- At least one course must meet the Human Diversity (HD) requirement. This is a graduation requirement for CCC.
- At City College of Chicago, choose a (G) Global Diversity and a (U) US Diversity course from recommended list to meet IWU graduation requirements. **Global diversity options:** ANTHRO 202, HIST 215, HIST 212, 247, HUM 215, MUS 183, POL SCI 204, SOC 210, SPANISH 104. **US Diversity options:** HIST 111, 112, 114, 115, 216, HUM 107, POL SCI 201, SOC 207
- It is recommended that you complete the IAI GECC through CCC. Meeting all of the GECC requirements will automatically meet the Illinois Wesleyan general education requirements. In this plan, you will leave CCC missing five courses to complete the GECC; two Social and Behavioral Sciences courses, and three courses in the Humanities/Fine Arts area. Ideally, you should complete these requirements at City Colleges through AP scores, dual credit, or summer coursework and leave CCC with your Associate in Arts degree.
- It may be possible to finish your GECC requirements at IWU and through the reverse transfer process, complete the requirements at CCC. In choosing those courses, please work with your advisor to also complete the IWU Encountering Diversity requirement.

- Students should work with their advisor or the department chair when selecting IWU courses, especially their upper level electives. Not all courses are offered each semester.
- Students should follow the Associates in Arts degree at CCC as opposed to the Associates in Science degree. The AA degree
  includes the Gen Ed Certificate, which is a complete package of transferable General Education Core Courses (GECC). If you
  leave CCC without completing the GECC, work with your Illinois Wesleyan advisor to complete remaining requirements for
  GECC at CCC and IWU shared curriculum requirements.
- AP scores of 3, 4 and 5 will receive 1 unit of credit. Higher level IB scores of 4 or higher will receive 1 unit of credit.
- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, remedial courses will not transfer to IWU. Adjust schedule and hour requirements accordingly to complete degree.
- The IWU Second Language requirement can be met by completing the intermediate level (XXXXX-103) course of any language or by earning a 4 or 5 on the AP exam in a second language. - Students should complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial or Physical Education courses, at City Colleges of Chicago to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of four years.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- IWU Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper level courses. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
