Major course electives should be selected with an IWU advisor based on an area of professional interest. Areas of Professional Interest: 1) Physical Therapy, 2) Occupational Therapy, 3) Strength & Conditioning/Personal Training, 4) Athletic Training, 5) Nutrition/Dietetics, 6) Sport Psychology

- Activity courses such as weight training are encouraged. However, physical education courses are not counted as academic units at IWU and will not count toward the 32 units required for graduation.
- Students should follow the Associates in Arts degree at Harper as opposed to the Associates in Science degree. The AA degree includes the Gen Ed Certificate, which is a complete package of transferable General Education Core Courses (IAI).
- AP scores of 3, 4, or 5 and Standard level IB scores of 5 or higher will receive 1 unit of credit.
- The IWU Second Language requirement can be met by completing the intermediate level (201) course of any
 language or by earning a 4 or 5 on the AP exam in a second language. Visit the IWU website for information:

- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, the remedial course will not transfer to IWU. Adjust course schedule accordingly to complete degree.
- Students should complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial or PE courses, at Harper to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of 4 years.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- IWU graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper level (300/400) courses. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
