- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, remedial
 courses will not transfer to IWU. Adjust schedule and hour requirements accordingly to complete
 degree.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- IWU Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper-level courses. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
