- IWU graduation requirements include a Global Diversity (G) and US Diversity (U) course. Both requirements are met with courses in the major at IWU. The (U) US Diversity course requirement is met with HLTH 101 at IWU. The (G) Global Diversity course requirement is met with HLTH 280 at IWU.
- AP scores of 3, 4 and 5 and Standard level IB scores of 5 or higher will receive 1 unit of credit.
- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, remedial courses will not transfer to IWU. Adjust schedule and hour requirements accordingly to complete degree.
- The IWU Second Language requirement can be met by completing the intermediate level (201) course of any language or by earning a 4 or 5 on the AP exam in a second language. Visit the IWU website for information: <https://www.iwu.edu/registrar/transfer-credit-faq.html>
- Students should complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial or equivalent PE courses, at Heartland to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of four years.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper-level courses. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
