If you are planning to pursue a career in physical therapy or nutrition/dietetics, you should choose CHEM 201 as your physical science and also complete CHEM 203. If you are pursuing a career in athletic training, select CHEM 201 as your physical science. Complete both BIOLOGY 226 & BIOLOGY 227 with a C or better to be equivalent to IWU 107 & 108.

- At least one course must meet the Human Diversity (HD) requirement. This is a graduation requirement for CCC.
- At City College of Chicago, choose a (G) Global Diversity and a (U) US Diversity course from this list to meet IWU requirements. **Global Diversity options:** ANTHRO 202, HIST 215, HIST 212, 247, HUM 215, MUS 183, POL SCI 204, SOC 210, SPANISH 104. **US Diversity options:** HIST 111, 112, 114, 115, 216, HUM 107, POL SCI 201, SOC 207.

Major course electives should be selected with an IWU advisor based on an area of professional interest. Areas of Professional Interest: 1) Physical Therapy, 2) Occupational Therapy, 3) Strength & Conditioning/ Personal Training, 4) Athletic Training, 5) Nutrition/ Dietetics, 6) Sport Psychology

- Physical Education courses such as weight training are encouraged. However, physical education courses are not counted as academic units at IWU and will not count toward the 32 units required for graduation.
- Students should follow the Associates in Arts degree at CCC as opposed to the Associates in Science degree. The AA degree includes the Gen Ed Certificate, which is a complete package of transferable General Education Core Courses (GECC).
- AP scores of 3, 4 and 5 and Standard level IB scores of 5 or higher will receive 1 unit of credit.
- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, remedial courses will
 not transfer to IWU. College Algebra, College Trigonometry, and Pre-Calculus are not transferable for credit.
 Adjust schedule and hour requirements accordingly to complete degree.
- The IWU Second Language requirement can be met by completing the intermediate level (103) course of any language or by earning a 4 or 5 on the AP exam in a second language. Visit the IWU website for information: https://www.iwu.edu/registrar/transfer-credit-faq.html
- Students should complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial or Physical Education courses, at City Colleges of Chicago to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of four years.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements
- IWU Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper level courses. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
